a touch of toast and a cascade of wisteria and acacia petals on the nose, followed by a mouthful of apples and lemons.	
<b>NV Brut Reserve, Taittinger, <i>France</i></b>	13 ~ 70
citrusy sparkling wine with subtle notes of brioche and white flowers; in the mouth it is fruity, honeyed and moreish.	
<b>NV Crémant de Bourgogne Brut Cuvée Excellence, Veuve Ambal, <i>France</i></b>	56
aromatic with hazelnut and citrus and boasting a long, honeyed finish.	
<b>NV Prestige Rose, Taittinger, <i>France</i></b>	80
with a noseful of freshly crushed wild raspberries, cherries and blackcurrants and a balanced mouthful of red fruit.

with flavours of green apple, pineapple, and a burst of citrus.	
<b>Petit Chenin Blanc, Ken Forrester Wines, <i>South Africa 2021</i></b>	9 ~ 11 ~ 30
fragrant with quince and pear drop, while green apple and grapefruit zap the tongue.	
<b>Yealands Estate Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, <i>New Zealand 2021</i></b>	10 ~ 12 ~ 35
tangy notes of passion fruit and blackcurrant leaf and fragrances of thyme and wet stone.	
<b>Bourgogne Chardonnay, Joseph Drouhin, <i>France 2020</i></b>	12 ~ 15 ~ 44
The aromas are reminiscent of fresh grape and green almond with an elegant texture.	
<b>Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de Bellemare, <i>France 2021</i></b>	42
delicate and floral, perfumed with hawthorn and lively with lemon, with a zip of salinity on the finish.	
<b>Eins Zwei Dry Rheingau Riesling, Weingut Leitz, <i>Germany 2020</i></b>	45
the nose a blend of spice and pineapple, the mouth a vibrant bowlful of tangerine and grapefruit.	
<b>Albariño, Ramón Bilbao, <i>Spain 2020</i></b>	46
tropical on the nose, with pineapple and passion fruit balanced by flowers and a juicy mouthful of apricot and mango.	
<b>The Hermit Crab Viognier/Marsanne, Originals, d'Arenberg, <i>Australia 2020</i></b>	48
powerfully aromatic white, blasting out candied ginger and flowers, with notes of green mango, hay and almond on the palate.	
<b>Pinot Bianco Cora DOC, Colterenzio, <i>Italy 2020</i></b>	50
with a dollop of honey balancing out the crisp acidity of all those fresh green apples.	
<b>Old Vine Semillon, Humberto Canale, <i>Argentina 2015</i></b>	51
aromatic with white fruits, herbs, and apples, elegant and complex.	
<b>Düfte Punkt Riesling Gewürztraminer Kerner, <i>Australia 2018</i></b>	52
heady with lime, flowers, and exotic spice.	
<b>Pinot Gris Réserve, Trimbach, <i>France 2017</i></b>	56
dry yet packed with fruit, with a touch of smokiness on the finish.	
<b>Pouilly-Fumé Les Duchesses, Domaine Laporte, <i>France 2020</i></b>	58
with a wisp of smoke on the nose and a lovely clean, lemony finish.	
<b>Trebbiano d'Abruzzo DOC Anfora Organic, Francesco Cirelli, <i>Italy 2019</i></b>	70
delicate aromas of yellow peaches, nectarines and flowers make for a balanced, fresh white.	
<b>Tarsanas Single Vineyard Assyrtiko, <i>Greece 2017</i></b>	75
The nose is dominated by aromas of apple, pear and citrus fruits, with a refreshing character.	
<b>Karia Chardonnay, Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, <i>USA 2018</i></b>	80
The palate is alive with citrus and light honey notes that lead to a lingering, fresh, mineral finish.	
<b>Chablis 1er Cru, Montée de Tonnerre, Domaine Louis Michel, <i>France 2018</i></b>	85
The citrus, green apple and pear fruit flavours last well into the deliciously refreshing, lengthy finish.	
<b>Meursault Blanc, Jean-Michel Gaunoux, <i>France 2018</i></b>	100
ripe and tropical on the nose, while the honeyed mouth is never cloying, thanks to fine acidity and well-formed fruit.

<b>Tinto Sobre Lias Garnacha, Care, <i>Spain 2020</i></b>	6 ~ 8 ~ 22
packed with raspberries and blackberries, with a faint, insistent aroma of spice.	
<b>Mountain Red Bordeaux Blend, Thelema, <i>South Africa 2018</i></b>	9 ~ 11 ~ 30
brimming with mulberries and plums, the fruit pepped up by a scattering of black pepper.	
<b>Trapiche Reserve, Malbec, <i>Argentina 2019</i></b>	10 ~ 12 ~ 35
heavily perfumed with baked plums, raisins, berries and hints of cacao and vanilla.	
<b>Rioja Crianza, Sierra Cantabria, <i>Spain 2018</i></b>	12 ~ 15 ~ 44
brimming with ripe cherries & other red fruit, the nose a sophisticated combination of spice, cocoa, and a wisp of smoke.	
<b>Saint Chinian, Domaine du Barres, <i>France 2020</i></b>	34
along with a generous portion of ripe mulberry and a flick of spice.	
<b>Nero d'Avola, Molino a Vento, IGT Terre Siciliane, <i>Italy 2021</i></b>	36
filled with red cherry and raspberry, with a fine minerality on the finish.	
<b>Syrah/Grenache Organic Rouge Canon du Maréchal, Domaine Cazes, <i>France 2020</i></b>	42
packed with red fruit, including redcurrants, raspberries, and cherries, with that dusting of spice on the finish.	
<b>Gallardia Cinsault De Martino, <i>Chile 2020</i></b>	46
The palate is fresh with ripe red berries, crisp acidity, soft tannins and a lovely long lingering finish.	
<b>Chinon Tradition, Pierre Sourdais, <i>France 2019</i></b>	50
soft, juicy Cabernet Franc from Chino in the central Loire Valley, this is lightly leafy and full of red fruit.	
<b>La Conquista! Tempranillo Garnacha Graciano, <i>Australia 2017</i></b>	54
The nose a Mediterranean-style riot of lavender and thyme, the mouth a burst of red berries, cherries and a touch of prune.	
<b>Rosso di Montepulciano, Poliziano, <i>Italy 2020</i></b>	55
all those flowers leavened with a slug of Merlot to keep the tannins gentle.	
<b>Massale Pinot Noir, Kooyong, <i>Australia 2020</i></b>	58
black cherry, summer berries and dried rose petals, followed by a beguiling mouthful of cranberries and more cherry.	
<b>Indian Wells Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Ste. Michelle, <i>USA 2018</i></b>	60
with notes of macerated cherry and blackcurrant in the mouth and vanilla and dried herbs on the nose.	
<b>Tamboerskloof Syrah, Kleinood, <i>South Africa 2017</i></b>	62
brimming with blackcurrants and plums, fragrant with white pepper, violet and a dusting of spice.	
<b>Côte de Beaune-Villages, Joseph Drouhin, <i>France 2018</i></b>	75
simple, elegant entry-level Burgundy, delicately bedecked with raspberries & redcurrants & lightly perfumed with spice.	
<b>Huellas Priorat, Massard, <i>Spain 2016</i></b>	81
complex red wine with a lattice of fine tannin supporting dark berries, herbs, a finishing flourish of spice.	
<b>Margaux, Le Relais de Durfort-Vivens, <i>France 2015</i></b>	85
aristocratic Bordeaux, the notes of red fruit shading into blueberry, violet a light whiff of tobacco, with a hint of vanilla.	
<b>Barbaresco Bordini DOCG, La Spinetta, <i>Italy 2018</i></b>	95
red fruit flavours well integrated with aromatic, light and delicate aromas. Fine tannins and breath-taking elegance.	
<b>Saint-Julien, Château Talbot 4ème Cru Classé, <i>France 2014</i></b>	140
aromatic with blackcurrants, leather, and herbs, all enhanced by chocolate, spice, and smoked oak on the palate.

Packed with strawberries, violets and a spritz of citrus, the powerful, red fruit nose belying the delicate colour.
